

AGE VERIFICATION POLICY FOR THE VIABLES COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

As a Premises Licence Holder, Viables Community Association accepts its responsibility to deter excessive alcohol consumption on its premises, and consequently the crime, disorder and public nuisance which it can cause.

In relation to the supply or sale of alcohol, the Association will ensure that individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 25 years of age must produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

For the purposes of identification, the Association will accept a passport, photo driving licence, or Proof of ID Age Card, or any other card bearing the above requirements.

The Association and any bar staff working on the premises reserve the right to refuse the sale of alcohol.

This policy is shared with the provider of the Association's Outsourced Bar Providers.
