For those of you who don't yet know us, we are Viables Community Association and we run your local community centre —The Roger Morris Centre, situated next to Eastrop Stores. Since taking over the running of the centre in Dec 2021, we have developed a lovely programme of activities and are establishing events for you to enjoy. The centre is open for hire for parties, events and regular hirer activities. We currently have boxing exercise classes, yoga, meditation, sound baths, dog walking, a wellbeing choir, Mencap, Tough Enough To Care male support group and LGBTQ+ support group, Indian dancing, Popstar Academy and more operating from our centre. Our own activities include a sight loss coffee morning, Weigh and Play, a support group for those with Premature Babies, Tiny Town and fayres which are open to all. Many of our activities are bookable but we also welcome you if you have not had time to do so. We would love to see you to show your support for this local community facility. We will soon be adding an outdoor shelter into our lovely garden too!
